Pursuant to Article 33 and 70 of the Law on Public Procurement ("Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina" No. 39/14) and Article 14 of the Rulebook on the Public Procurement of the City Administration of the City of Banja Luka ("Official Gazette of the City of Banja Luka" No. 34/19 and 23/21), and in accordance with the provisions of the Guidelines on the Organization and Conduct of Competitions in the Field of Architecture and Urban Planning ("Official Gazette of the City of Banja Luka" No. 6/18) and the proposal of the Competition Jury for the development of the concept urban, landscape and architectural design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka of 29 December 2021, the Mayor of the City of Banja Luka, made on 4 January 2022, the following

DECISION

- I The proposal of the Competition Jury for the Public Procurement no. 03-404-87/21/ "Competition for the development of the concept urban, landscape and architectural design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka," on the following awards is accepted as follows:
1. FIRST PRIZE in the amount of EUR 15,000.00 (the equivalent in BAM) is not awarded;
  2. TWO EQUAL SECOND PRIZES in the amount of EUR 7,500.00 EUR each (the equivalent in BAM) is awarded TO:
    - the proposal under the author's code „OO10110“- *Team of authors:* Fedor Jurić, B.Arch, Ognjen Graovac, B.Arch and Luka Bunčić, B.Arch, all from Serbia, and
    - the proposal under the author's code „70391LK“ – *Team of authors:* Nikolina Hassam Dorsen, Srđan Lakić and Andrea Janičić from Banja Luka;
  3. TWO EQUAL THIRD PRIZES, in the amounts of EUR 3.750,00 each (the equivalent in BAM) is awarded for:
    - the proposal under the author's code „11337AZ“- *Team of authors:* Amina Chouairi, Alessandro de Cadilhac, Camilla Di Nicola, Geronimo Felici Fioravanti and Chiara Magnini, all from Italy; and
    - the proposal under the author's code „00000PA“- *Team of authors:* "NATURALIST TEAM", *Team of authors:* Petar Tošić, M.Arch, Teodora Jeremić, M.Arch, Nevena Petrović, M.Arch, Jovan Jovanović, M.Arch and Boban Tošić, B.Arch, all from Serbia.



- II. In compliance with the requirements of the Competition Announcement, the proposal of the Competition Jury to issue non-monetary HONORABLE MENTIONS for the following author's proposals is accepted:
- the proposal under the author's code „31100ES“ – *Team of authors:* Andrii Lesyuk, Kohut Mykhailo, Mariia Shkolnyk, Dovbush Sofiia, Tereza Karlyk, Hordii Sviatyi, Kateryna Ivashchuk, Sofiia Shkoliar and Bondarenko Yeva, all from Ukraine, and
  - the proposal under the author's code „DS66577“- *Team of authors:* Jovana Kovačević, M.Arch, Miloš Jokić, Msc Arch, Nikola Gjorgjievski, M.Arch, Stefan Ilić, M.Arch, and Tijana Mačkić, M.Arch, all from Serbia.
- III. The Finance Department of the City Administration of the City of Banja Luka is responsible for the implementation of this Decision .
- III. A written complaint may be lodged with the Mayor against this Decision within five days from the date when the notification is received. The complaint is to be submitted through Department of Spatial Planning of the City Administration of the City of Banja Luka.

### **Statement of Reasons**

The Competition Jury for the Development of the concept urban, landscape and architectural design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka appointed by the Decision of the Mayor no.12-G-1198/21 of 21 May 2021, in accordance with the Instructions on the Organization and Conduct of Competitions in the Field of Architecture and Urban Planning (“Official Gazette” of the City of Banja Luka, No. 6/18) and the requirements of the Call for Proposals, conducted the procedure for selecting the best concept design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka.

On 1 October 2021, the Public Procurement Notice was published on the website of the Public Procurement Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in the daily newspaper "Nezavisne novine", on the official website of the City of Banja Luka and in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina” number 62/21 of 8 October 2021.

In compliance with the requirements defined in the Competition Announcement, a total of thirty-one (31) competition proposals arrived within the deadline, via the set link.

Examination of the received proposals was made by the Expert Rapporteurs in the period from October 6 December 2021 until 16 December 2021. On 17 December 2021, the Report was submitted in writing to the Competition Jury and each proposal was individually verbally explained (Attachment: Report on the Submitted Proposals to the International Public Competition for the development of the concept urban, landscape and architectural design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka – December 2021).



The Competition Jury reviewed all 31 competition proposals and analyzed them individually against the established criteria and requirements defined by the Competition Announcement and the Program of the competition, and decided as follows:

1. Competition proposals under the following author's code are eligible for participation: 01 („87535AE“), 03 („88866LL“), 05 („78000BL“), 06 („DY86888“), 07 („HX00062“), 08 („16161LA“), 09 („00079AK“), 10 („31572ER“), 11 („31100ES“), 12 („39080PU“), 13 („77777MK“), 14 („11337AZ“), 15 („DT14025“), 16 („IDDQD42“), 17 („08098AG“), 19 („Ta10198“), 20 („OO10110“), 21 („XY06951“), 22 („70391LK“), 23 („DS66577“), 24 („NE25843“), 25 („20201GR“), 27 („00000PA“), 29 („LE85693“), 30 („61119MS“) and 31 („01010LB“);
2. There are no attachments in the received competition proposals that should be excluded from the evaluation process;
3. Due to the failure to meet obligatory requirements of the Competition Announcement, competition proposals under the following working numbers are ineligible for further evaluation:
  - 02 („MTHNF21“) - The proposal does not contain all the attachments defined by the Competition Announcement, and a number of attachments are not finalized, hence it is evident that the proposal is not complete;
  - 04 („00331OS“) - The proposal does not contain all the attachments defined by the Competition Announcement, and a number of attachments are not finalized, hence it is evident that the proposal is not complete;
  - 18 („15101FP“) - The author violated the principle of anonymity, as the author's name is indicated on a number of graphic attachments;
  - 26 („22022KN“) - The proposal does not contain all the attachments defined by the Competition Announcement, a number of attachments are not finalized, and the author violated the principle of anonymity, as the author's name is indicated on one graphic attachment.
  - 28 („81228yn“) - The proposal does not contain all the attachments defined by the competition announcement, hence it is incomplete and not finalized.

The Competition Jury examined and evaluated each individual proposal according to the defined criteria, by comparative evaluation of the quality of the submitted designs classified according to the common characteristics of the concepts. The Competition Jury selected the proposals in four rounds and evaluated and scored the competition proposals from the shortlist, and ranked them according to the quality of the offered designs respecting the purpose of the competition, the goal of the competition task and evaluation criteria. Pursuant to the provisions of Articles 41 and 67 of the Guidelines on the organization and conduct of the competitions in the area of architecture and spatial planning (“Official Gazette of the City of Banja Luka, number 6/18) and Item 6 of the Competition Announcement, the Competition Jury has decided to use the opportunity and redistribute the number and order of prizes within the total prize fund, by not awarding the first prize, but by awarding two equal second prizes in the amount of EUR 7,500.00 each (equivalent in BAM) to the proposals under the author's codes "OO10110" and "70391LK", and two equal third prizes in the amount of 3,750.00

EUR each (equivalent in BAM) to the proposals under the author's codes "11337AZ" and "00000PA".

The Competition Jury proposed that the non-monetary HONORABLE MENTION be awarded to two competition proposals under the author's codes: "31100ES" and "DS66577", who have achieved artistic value and representativeness with their idea and the quality of concept design and thus contributed to a broader reflection on some of the topics that stood out in this competition.

Based on the above stated, at its session held on 29 December 2021, the Competition Jury decided and submitted to the Contracting Authority the Minutes on the evaluation of the submitted proposals and the Final Report on the work of the Competition Jury with the list of the proposed awards for the International Public Competition for the development of the concept urban, landscape and architectural design of the park along the Serbian Army Boulevard in Banja Luka.

The proposal of the Competition Jury was accepted; hence it was decided as in the dispositive.
